Our Teams Through the Years



The girls' basketball teams of 1919 and 1921 boasted a record in basketball which no other school in the Southeast can share. Under the direction of Coach Frank M. Staley, the originator of girls' basketball, beginning in 1919, the college passed through a period of eight years with only three defeats. For five years, the team played without a defeat. The team never lost a game until they invaded Alabama and met Tuskegee. In 1922, the Sextette succeeded in winning a silver loving cup, given by Mrs. Marion B. Wilkinson, being the first team to win the championship for three consecutive years. In 1924, the squad lost only one game to Paine College of Augusta, Georgia, downing every other foe who they met. In 1925, the team opened the gates once more with a whirlwind, losing only one time before Paine College in Augusta. The coaches in 1925 were Isabelle M. Hurlong and ? Belton.






